Oklahoma National Stockyards - Week-
ly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Feeder cattle
steady, except steers over 825 lbs 3.00 low-
er. Demand good for feeders under 825 lbs.
Steer and heifer calves steady to 4.00 low-
er, most decline under 500 lbs. Demand
moderate for heavy calves destined for
feedlots. Demand light for calves under
500 lbs. Farmers are not highly motivated
to accumulate their light calf needs. Still no
rain in the state and wheat pastures are
looking bleak. Combine this with October's
temperature stress on calves and you get
more wait and see than actual grazing
orders. Yearling quality average; calves
average to attractive. Flesh conditions of
yearlings medium; calves in medium to
moderate flesh. Weigh-ups average to full.
Slaughter cows steady to mostly 1.00 high-
er. Slaughter bulls steady. Packer demand
moderate. Very good demand for bred
cows, pairs, and grazing or feeder cows.
Several sets of good quality replacement
cows and pairs offered. Few lots fancy
northern quality young black bred cows

from reputation ranch bred to reputation
black bulls established the top side of the
bred cow market. Total of 1,050 cows and
bulls sold with 50 percent to packers.
Receipts this week 12,550; last week
11,710; last year 9,191. Supply consisted
of 45 percent yearlings and calves over 600
lbs; 46 percent calves under 600 lbs; 9 per-
cent cows and bulls. Heifers comprised 41
percent of feeder and calf supply. Prices
follow with weighted average weight and
price in parenthesis.

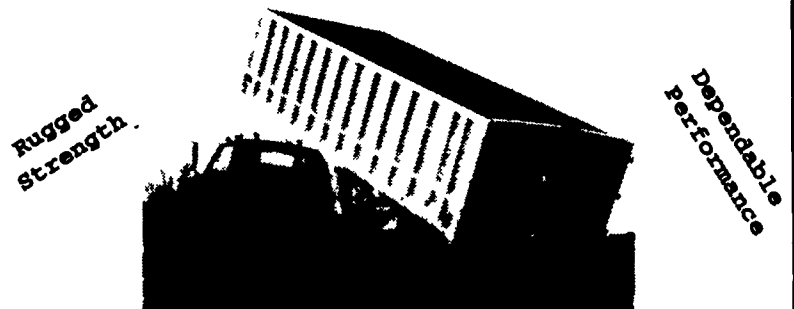
