THE COWBOY PHILOSOPHER

fill Rogers, born William Penn Adair on November 4, 1879, started his cowboy days on vaudeville and later joined the Ziegfeld Follies, in 1914. His talents were showcased on radio, on the stage, and in films, but it was perhaps his stint as a newspaper columnist that gave him the title "cowboy philosopher." More than a comedian, Will Rogers was a commentator on the American scene and politics. "I hope we never live to see the day when a thing is as bad as some of our newspapers make it," he said in 1934. About the foibles of the entertainment business, he confessed, "I am not a real movie star — I've still got the same wife I started out with 28 years ago.'






