USDA issued the Cold Storage report today. September ending stocks of American cheese were revised up from 471.447 million pounds issued October 20 to 474 846 million pounds today. October stocks of American cheese are 456 976 million pounds, down 1787 million pounds from the month before and up 15 8 percent from a year ago September butter stocks were revised down from 74 055 million pounds issued October 20 to 71 473 million pounds today October ending butter stocks are at 59 864 million pounds, down 11 609 million ponds from the month before and up 92 1 percent from a year ago

The cold storage report shows two things First, October levels of butter and cheese are still well above year ago levels. Second, these stock levels are below September levels My conclusion is that this report indicates that third quarter consumption of dairy products (July - September) must have been very strong, and that current consumption must also be strong.

Stocks would be growing if consumption were weak.

The market will likely interpret this report as neutral to bullish on prices In other words, it is clear that stocks, while high from historical levels, are heading down and that demand is strong That should help to stabilize prices I expect overall demand for cheese the fourth quarter to be strong. The stock market reacted favorably when the Federal Reserve Board increased the federal funds rate a quarter point this week Recent reports on retail sales look favorable Inus despite higher interest rates and higher gas prices, retail sales this holiday season could be very good

That could also mean higher sales for dairy products as optimistic shoppers eat out and entertain more at home

Thus higher cheese consumption may prevent cheese

pound blocks were \$1.1225 per pound on Monday, November 15 and fell to \$1.12 per pound by Friday, November 19. Barrel cheese remained steady at \$1.0975 per pound all week.

Cheese prices could remain at weak levels for the next two weeks as surplus milk from the Thanksgiving Holiday flows into manufacturing facilities. Prices may strengthen slightly in

December from current levels if demand remains strong and stocks continue to decline. If, however, stock levels stabilize next month due to strong cheese production levels, cheese prices could remain just above support levels for the remainder of the year
