(Continued from Page A1) for \$700. Both traditional and contemporary style quilts were auctioned. The two highest bids of \$950 each went to quilts titled Tree of Life and Country Love.

The Trust had set a goal to preserve 100 farms by its 10th anniversary. Tom Stouffer, execu-

tive director, said that the 104 farms preserved is the highest number preserved of any county in

Stouffer credits the generosity of farmers and supporters because no government money is used, and full value for easements were not given for the 6,882 acres pre-

"More than \$10 million in easements have been donated by farmers. This speaks volumes for Lancaster County farmers," Stouf-

Stouffer encouraged the audience to support House Bill 300, and to work for laws that would allow annual tax breaks to farmers, not just a one-time allotment.

The Trust has 2,000 members. Last year the Trust spent \$600,000 to preserve the easement value of \$21/4 million of farm land.
