CATTLE: Compared to Tuesday, the slaughter steer and heifer market was uneven. Top quality high Choice and Prime cattle sold fully 1.00 higher with good demand. Average or common quality steers and heifers traded steady to only .50 higher with late sales fading. Overall, the market rebounded from a midweek slump but still ended the week .50-1.00 lower. A good run of Holstein steers sold fully steady. Slaughter cows sold mostly steady to .50 lower and slaughter bulls were active, but 1.00-2.00 lower than Monday's active market. Supply included 32 percent slaughter steers and 41 percent slaughter cows.


