CATTLE Compared to Thursday slaughter steers steady, although High Choice and Prime scarce. Holstein steers steady. Slaughter heifers weak to 50 lower. Cows 50 100 higher with several 1500 1900 lbs Holsteins, mainly High dressing Lean and Boners. Bull scarce. Trend on feeders not comparable but demand good. Supply included 21 percent slaughter steers, 38 percent cows, 34 percent feeders, with the balances slaughter heifers and bulls.
