Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending December 11, 1999 were 17% more than last week, and 1% more than a year ago. Shell egg supplies were sufficient for trade needs.

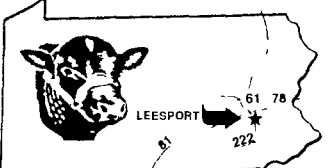
