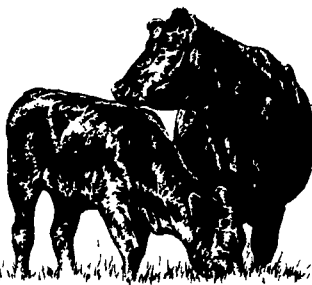

CATTLE Compared to Tuesday, slaughter steers sold steady to 50 higher to end the week firm to 1.00 higher. The offering was fairly plain in quality, especially early in the sale, and prices improved as buyers tried to pick through the mixed supply to fill orders A light test of Holstein steers sold fully steady and slaughter heifers were not well tested. Slaughter cows sold mostly steady with only minimal signs of weakness leading up to the holiday weekend. Slaughter bulls were active and 50-1.50 higher Supply included 35 percent slaughter steers and 45 percent slaughter cows.

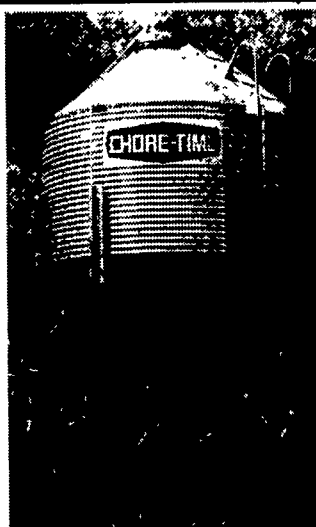

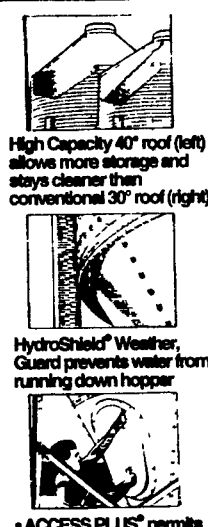

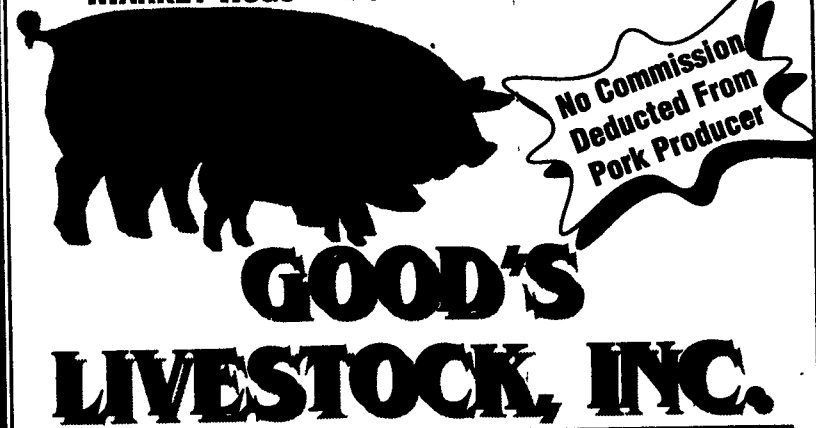
