Extension To Conduct Soybean School

NORTH CORN-WALL (Lebanon Co.) — Penn State Cooperative Extension will be conducting a one-day soybean school for area farmers at the Lebanon County Agricultural Center Wednesday, Feb. 2.
 Sign-in will begin at 8:30 a.m. and will conclude by 3:30 p.m., according to John Rowehl, regional agricultural agent for grain crops.
 "This is intended for someone that is relatively new to soybean production and looking for the basic fundamentals. We are going to cover everything from plant growth to cultural practices and pest management of soybeans," said Rowehl, regional extension agent coordinating the school. "Participants will take an active part in some problem-solving exercises, so this will not just be a sit-and-listen meeting."
 John Yocum and Elwood Hatley, Penn State extension specialists in soybean management, will assist in conducting the program.
 There is a \$25 fee for attending this school. This covers reference material and lunch.
 The soybean school is also open to anyone working in the business of crop input supply and service. Call the Lebanon County Cooperative Extension office at (717) 270-4391 to register by Friday, Jan. 28 so that adequate arrangements can be made.
