Another featured speaker on the program this year is Gene

Lewis from the United Soybean Board. Lewis is a Hardinsburg, Ind. soybean and corn farmer who will be making two pre-

sentations: one on "Ag Perspectives For 2000" and another on "New Uses Development and the Soybean Board."

The conference will also feature Gene Gantz, a crop insurance consultant, with a session on the upcoming significant changes in crop insurance and how they will affect Pennsylvania grain farmers. Gene has considerable experience working with midwest producers using crop insurance as part of financing and grain marketing programs.

The conference will also review the potential of lightbars for sprayer guidance. This is a precision ag application that some corn producers think has a real fit in Pennsylvania. The

program will also feature panel of grain merchants who will share some of their thoughts on the current GMO situation.

The conference will also feature numerous industry exhibits, Five-Acre Corn Club awards, and the Pennsylvania Soybean Contest results. The

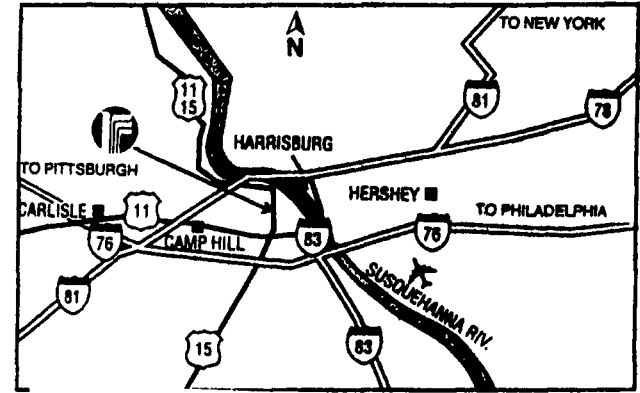
