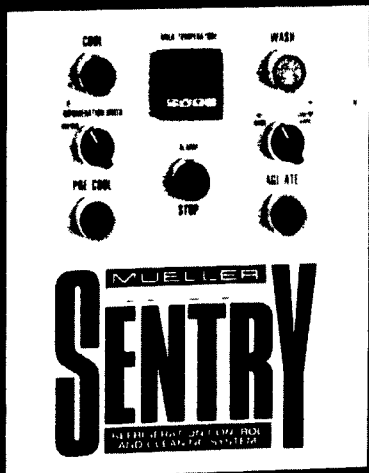
last year. This in spite of, or because of, the 15 to 20 percent increase in milk handled. A total of 418,530,541 pounds of milk was sold with most of it going to Kemps and Turkey Hill in Lancaster County.

Membership in the Coopera-

tive also increased by 15 to 20 percent. Officials noted that the investment in the Cooperative by the average patron decreased by 35 percent this year to only \$2,384.

Lancaster County dairy princess, Elisa Ranck, spoke, and Dale Hershey, cooperative manager gave a report. Don Risser, president was in charge of the meeting. The election of directors will be reported next week.
