Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Receipts reduced by last week's winter storm. Much of the state still covered with snow and ice. Feeder cattle and few calves steady to 2.00 higher. Demand excellent for light receipts. Bulk receipts feeder steers over 650 lbs. Slaughter cows and bulls 2.50-4.00 higher. Packer demand very good for light receipts. Forecast is good for next week with large numbers of feeders and cows expected. Total of 85 cows and bulls sold with 65 percent to packers. Receipts this week 1,375; last week 11,879; last year 4,979. Supply consisted of 86 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 8 percent calves under 600 lbs; 6 percent cows

and bulls. Heifers comprised 18 percent of feeder and calf supply. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

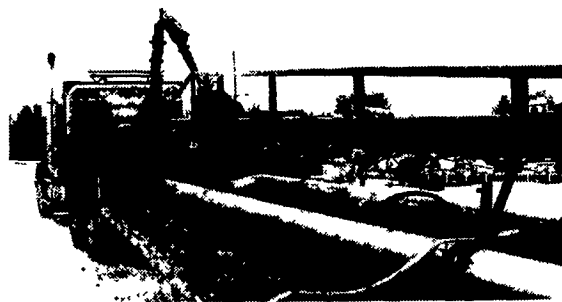
