## National Dairy Shrine Boosts Scholarship Funding

COLUMBUS, Oh.—National Dairy Shrine, the "Hall of Fame" of the dairy industry, has approved scholarships and awards totalling over \$30,000 for 2000. This is twice the amount distributed in 1999, according to Dr. Thomas Aitchison, President of the organization. The organization increased the funding to recognize and reward outstanding young people in the dairy industry.

These include:

- NDS/DMI Milk Marketing Scholarships—five to seven scholarships awarded annually (One at \$1,000; balance \$500 scholarships) for college students interested in careers in milk marketing.
- McCullough Scholarships—two scholarships (\$2,500 and \$1,000) for high school seniors planning to enter a four-year college or

university.

- Kildee Scholarships—up to two \$3,000 scholarships awarded annually for advanced study in dairy to one of the top individuals in the National Intercollegiate Dairy Judging Contest.
- Student Recognition Contest—cash awards to encourage graduating college seniors to work with dairy cattle after graduation. Must be nominated by college or university.
- Progressive Dairy Producer Award—three \$2,000 educational travel awards targeting outstanding young dairy producers 21-45 years of age.

Deadline for applications for all awards and scholarships is **March 15, 2000**.
