urgent rather than on what's important.

He forsees medical and pharmaceutical uses for food as a potential breakthrough. He cited recent research that extracts a substance from milk that is placed on cuts and results in healing within a few hours.

"Surviving in the next millenium depends on how to take a product and add value. Bottled water is an example of a valueadded product. Bottled water has skyrocked in price, costing \$280 a barrel compared to \$28 for oil.

Other speakers at the seminar held at the Farm and Home Center on Feb. 24, included Ronald Hanson, agribusiness professor; and John Blanchfield, manager of agricultureal banking and rural development for the American Bankers Association. Student remarks were heard from Jennifer Zimmerman, county FFA president, and Sarah Boyd, Superior 4-H award recipient for the county.


Club held its first two meetings on January 4 and February 1. During the January meeting,


