


You can help the environment both "downstream," when products are disposed of, and "upstream," when they are manufactured.

By not using unnecessary products or packaging, we don't just avoid having to send it to landfills or incinerators.


We also avoid having to expend the energy, consume the natural resources and create the pollution that comes from manufacturing it in the first place!

A ton of paper made from 100% recycled paper saves the equivalent of:

- * 4,100 kwh energy
- ♦ 7,000 gallons of water
- ♦ 60 pounds of air emissions
- ❖ 3 cubic yards of landfill space



- ♦ \$10 billion was spent in the US to dispose of trash in 1990.
- * Americans throw away enough aluminum cans every 3 months to rebuild the entire US commercial air fleet.
- \$\display 5\$ million homes could be heated
 for 200 years with the wood and
