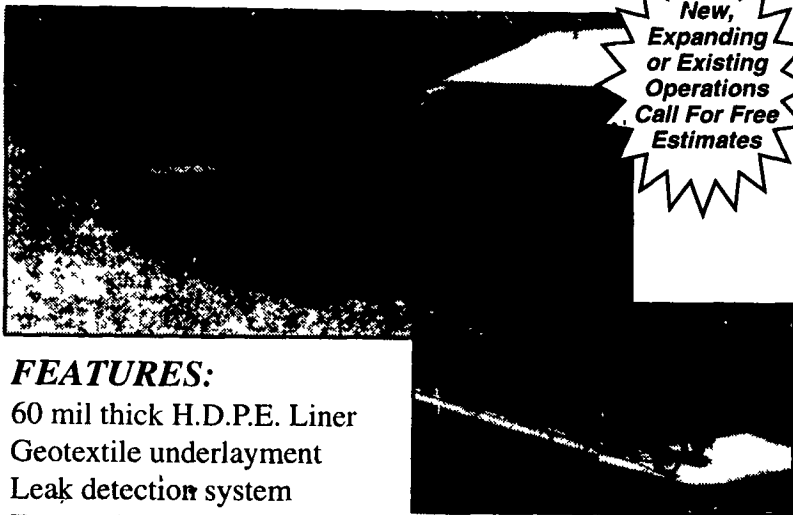

Dairy Industry Calls for Producer Input on Maryland's Nutrient Management Regulations

WASHINGTON, D.C.—The State of Maryland should include dairy producers and their industry representatives in developing nutrient management regulations, according to the Maryland Dairy Industry Association (MDIA).

The state industry group representing more than 800 dairy farm families says that practical on-farm ex-

perience is necessary in order to draft state regulations that protect both producers and the state's natural resources.

MDIA was reacting to the Maryland Department of Agriculture's (MDA) proposed regulations that require the state's agricultural producers to develop and implement nutrient management plans for their farms. The asso-

ciation convened a task force of producers, academic, and Extension officials to review and prepare comments on MDA's recently published draft of proposed regulations.

"Maryland's proximity to urban centers and the Chesapeake Bay makes our nutrient management proposals unique among our sister states," says Myron L.

Wilhide, a third-generation dairy producer and president of the Maryland Dairy Industry Association. "We believe that comprehensive cost-sharing, easy access to qualified advisory personnel, and practical producer input are critical to developing an acceptable nutrient management plan."

MDIA's recommendations to Royden Powell, the Maryland Department of Agriculture's assistant secretary for resource conservation, emphasized these points:

- Maryland Department of Agriculture should appoint a producer/advisory committee to have input in and oversight of the state's Nutrient Management Manual regulating on-farm plans;

- Nutrient management plans should be farm-specific, encompassing size, management history, and economics of that operation;

- Maryland Department of Agriculture should be the primary and regulatory authority on nutrient management plans, not environmental agencies;

- Adequate cost-sharing and/or financial assistance, as well as professional counsel, should be made available to producers for state-required nutrient management plans;

- Nutrient management plans should include assistance for any required off-farm storage, transportation, and disposal of manure;

Maryland is requiring dairy and other producers to review and comment on proposed nutrient management regulations no later than March 15, 2000.

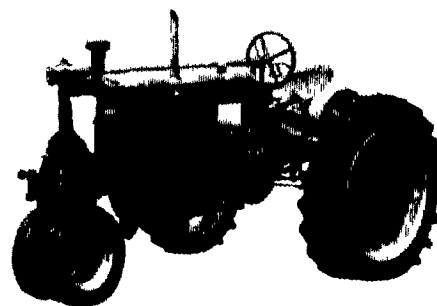
