Compared to last week: Feeder steers steady to 1.00 higher; feeder heifers steady to 1.00 lower. Demand good for feeder cattle. Stocker cattle and calves steady. Demand continues extremely good for grazing cattle. The mild winter has caused cattle on wheat to finish ahead of schedule this season with the March wheat run occuring mostly in February. Same is expected for the May run which will likely concentrate in April. March rains have been generous statewide. Spring grazing will be optimal. Quality average to attractive. Feeder cattle in slightly thin to moderate flesh, end fleshy. Weigh-ups remain highly varied and in complete range of gaunt to full. Slaughter cows steady to 1.00 lower. Slaughter bulls steady. Packer demand moderate. Demand very good for thin grazing type cows. Total of 415 cows and bulls sold with 35 percent to packers. Receipts this week 8,960; last week 10,394; last year 11,587. Supply consisted of 75 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 20 percent calves and short yearlings under 600 lbs; 5 percent cows and bulls. Heifers comprised 39 percent of feeder and calf supply. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
