

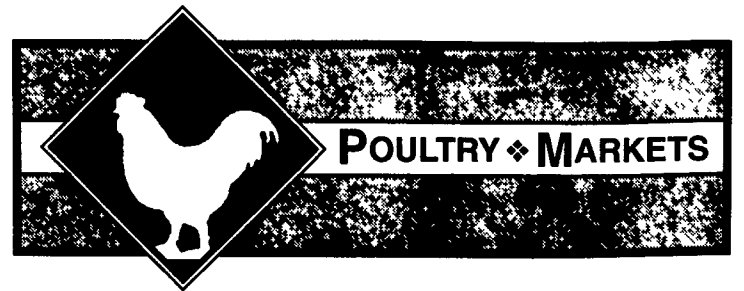

Majority prices were unchanged on truck lot trading when compared to last week's values. Demand remain light and usually unaggressive for sufficient offerings. The undertone was mixed but generally steady on whites and whole, and cautious on yolks. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending April 01, 2000 were 5 % more than last week, and 6 % more than a year ago. Shell egg suppliers were usually adequate for needs.
