Supplies of all sizes continued adequate. Breaking stock supplies were more than adequate from regular sources, and demand for additional quality product was limited. Light type fowl were sufficient for processors' current needs.

Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was slowing. Offerings varied both by size and from plant to plant, but were adequate overall. Live supplies were mostly moderate; weights were mixed and irregular in a full range of light to heavy. Processing schedules were moderate to moderately heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 56 to 68 cents. Trade sentiment was steady to fully steady. In the parts complex, buying interest had tapered. Inquiry centered on tight supplies of whole breasts for deboners. Leg items were in fairly good balance. Boneless skinless breasts and wings were available and slow in clearing.

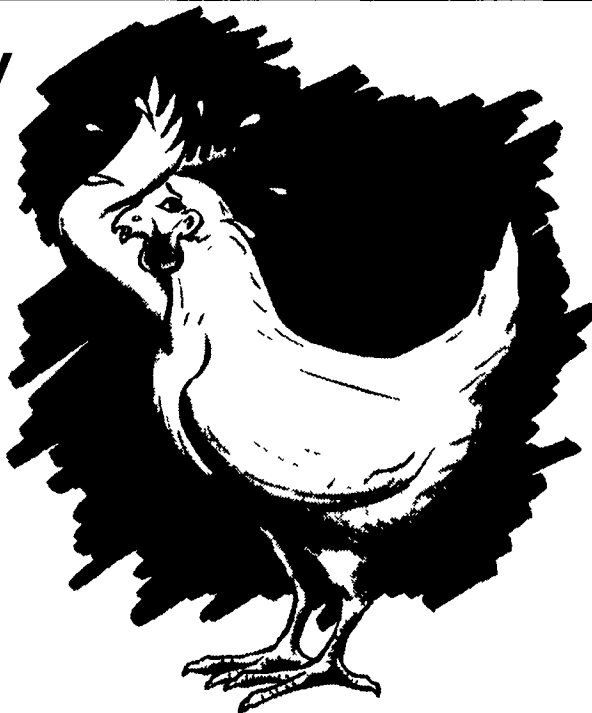
