Light supply stockers and calves steady with very good demand for any weight thru mid 700 lb steer suitable to graze Hard thin yearling type calf weights becoming more scarce each week with more fleshy new crops making up the mix Feeder flesh conditions typical for this time of year and continues to increase as wheat is well headed. Bulk of feeders in slightly fleshy to fleshy condition. Weigh-ups gaunt to average. Quality average to attractive for kind though flesh often detrimental.  
 Slaughter cows and bulls steady to 1.00 higher. Packer demand moderate Bulk of cow receipts slaughter types and low-end replacements. Total of 280 cows and bulls sold with 60 percent to packers. Receipts this week 13,000; last week 14,419; last year 12,331.  
 Supply consisted of 91 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 9 percent calves under 600 lbs. Heifers comprised 37 percent of feeder and calf supply.

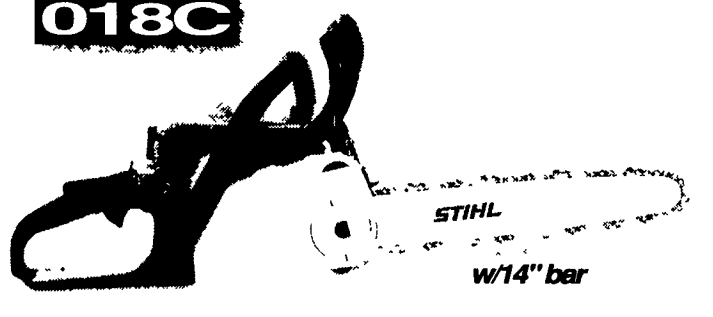
