Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was seasonally slow to fair. Offerings were fully adequate to ample and in heaviest supply on the 2.5 pound sizes which were competitively priced in an effort to stimulate activity. Live supplies were mostly moderate; weights re-

mained irregularly light to heavy. Processing schedules were moderate to moderately heavy. Several plants plan to close tomorrow Friday or Monday in observance of the religious holidays. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 56 to 68 cents. Trade sentiment was about steady. Bone-in breasts were readily available. Other cuts were adequate.

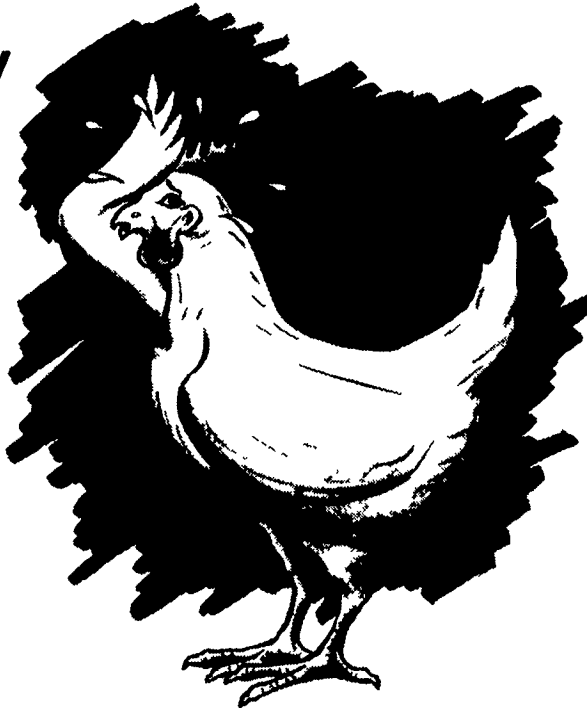

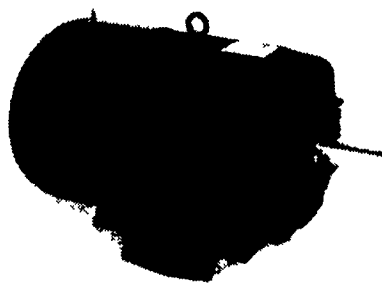
