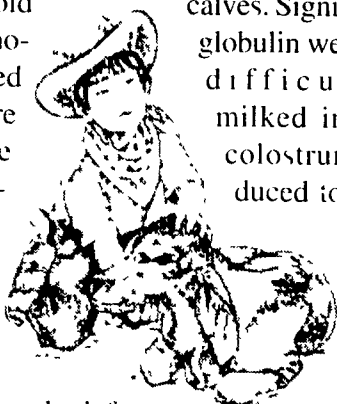

**BEEF TIPS**

**Calving Ease Target  
of Simmental Breeders**

A study at Colorado State University confirms the importance  
of calving ease to the amount of immuno-globulin concentra-  
tions in the blood of one day old calves. Signifi-  
cantly lower levels of the immuno-  
globulin were  
found in calves that experienced  
difficult  
births—even when the cows were  
milked im-  
mediately and the calf was fed the  
colostrum.  
Calving difficulty must be re-  
duced to  
decrease the incidence of new-  
born diseases such as scours and  
pneumonia. Simmental breed-  
ers record and rate all Simmen-  
tals in 7 categories—the first  
category is calving ease. When you look for a  
herd sire—you may want to check out his calving ease num-  
bers.
