Magee Negotiates Successful Agriculture Budget for N.Y. State

ONEIDA, N.Y. - Agriculture has come out a winner in these final days of budget negotiations.

The legislative budget conference subcommittee Transportation/Environmental Conservation/Housing/ Agriculture recommended a \$3.5 million increase in agricultural spending. Committee member and Assembly Agriculture Chairman Bill Magee (D-Nelson) was successful in securing the increase.


Magee worked hard fighting the Senate to leave the \$1.3 million the governor had allocated for the Farmland Viability Program, which Magee championed in 1999. The purpose of the Farmland Viability Program is to strengthen and improve the viability of New York State's agricultural industry, both economically and environmentally.

The recommendations for funding additions to the Executive proposal are: Apiary Research and Inspection, \$275,300; Cornell Onion Research, \$100,000; NYS Apple Growers Association, \$125,000; Cornell Ag in the Classroom, \$60,000; Cornell Future Farmers, \$35,000; Golden Nematode,

\$50,700; Cornell Rabies, \$200,000; Central NY AgriTourism, \$100,000; NYS Wine and Grape, \$250,000; North Country Agriculture, \$400,000; Marine Resources, \$100,000; Cornell Cattle Health Database, \$50,000; Montgomery County Agricultural Economic Development Office, \$50,000; SUNY Morrisville Agricultural Incubator Program, \$500,000; Migrant Child Care, \$175,000; State Fair Highway Lights, \$60,000; Madison County Fair Sanitary Improvements, \$130,000; Geneva Experimental Station, \$224,000; Agriculture Teachers Recruitment Program, \$40,000; Johne's Disease Diagnostic Lab at Cornell, \$300,000; Equine Testing, \$75,000; Seed Testing \$200,000.

"Industry programs such as Farmland Viability, Cornell Apiary Research, and the Geneva Experiment Station are crucial to agriculture in New York and are programs I am happy to initiate or increase spending on. These budget recommendations are a step in the right direction to keeping New York farms sustainable, profitable and progressive in the twenty-first century," Magee said.

Franklin County Honors DHIA Award Winners

The Mellotts received a 1999 PA DHIA Herd Management Award with their Jersey herd. Marcus and Chester Martin's cow Two-Top Dolores produced 247,255 pounds of milk in 10 lactations. A second Martin cow, Framer Kasper Negra produced 228,203 pounds of milk during her lifetime which covered nine lactations. Goshorn's herd average somatic cell count for the year, 109 thousand, was the lowest in the county for PA DHIA herds. The Goshorns have a herd of 85 Holstein cows.

The retiring director provided leadership several years ago when the county DHIA association merged with the state DHIA organization.
