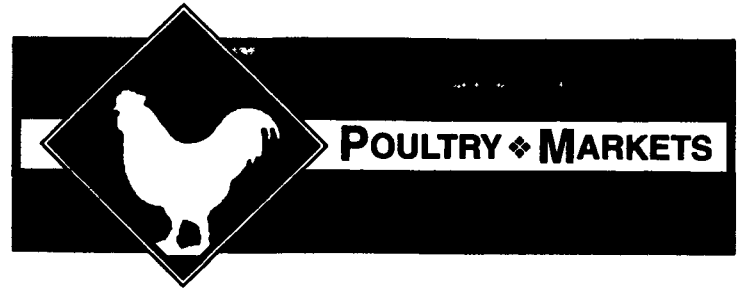

EASTERN REGION FROZEN EGGS, APRIL 21, 2000. FEDERAL-STATE

Prices ranged from unchanged to slightly higher on whites, balance of trucklot items were usually unchanged when compared to last week's values. Demand remained light and unaggressive as some traders anticipate some competitive pricing in the near future. Offerings were at least sufficient for current needs. The undertone was mixed and unsettled. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending April 15, 2000 were 3 % more than last week, and 8 % less than a year ago. Shell egg suppliers were sufficient for needs.
