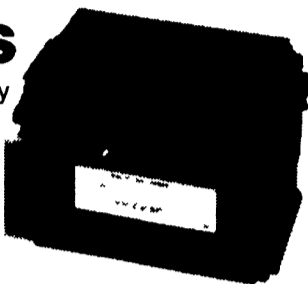

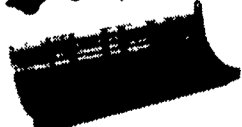

Shenk started the bus making project in the fall and worked on it evenings whenever it fit into his schedule.

Shenk has no plans to retire. He said, "I like my grandchildren (he has seven) and my bus children. I miss both the children and the driving during the summer months."

His wife said, "He really has patience. I marvel at how he handles problems."

"You must be a little of a lot of different people—mother, father, pastor, nurse, and psychiatrist," Shenk said of bus drivers.
