Clearly print or type your recipe entry. Be sure to give accurate measurements, temperatures, times, and sizes of baking dishes to use. We reserve the right to disqualify entries if

these guidelines are not followed.

The difference between this contest and the weekly recipes is that you are asked to include a few paragraphs about yourself and your family. Although it is not required, a photograph of you or with your family adds a wonderful touch to accompany the printed submission. Photos will be returned if you write your name and address on the back of the picture.

Only one entry per family allowed. This contest is for adults who are 18-years-old or older, not children. Send your recipe, photo, and accompanying infor-

mation with your complete address. If we do not have your complete mailing address, we cannot send your prize if you win.

Send entries immediately. Entries must be postmarked by June 1 to be eligible for the drawing. The state dairy princess and alternates will select the winners through a drawing. ## Foreign Companies Optimistic About China Joining WTO

HONG KONG — China's membership in the World Trade Organization (WTO) will bring important new opportunities for agricultural trade, executives of foreign companies say.

However, they caution the benefits will come gradually and bring painful adjustments to China's economy, which will raise political risk.

The opportunity to bypass government bureaucracy and directly serve flour mills, meat importers, or other Chinese customers is a major advantage, said an executive at an international agricultural trading company.

China, which has embarked on sweeping economic reforms, has been trying for the last 14 years to join the body which sets global trade rules and could clear the final hurdles this year.

Japanese trading company Itochu Hong Kong, which trades commodities and invests in supermarkets in China, is careful not to expect too much from China's WTO membership, said A. Nakajima, general manager for foodstuffs.

"It doesn't mean 1.3 billion people are going to be good consumers, ready to spend their money on everything," Nakajima said.

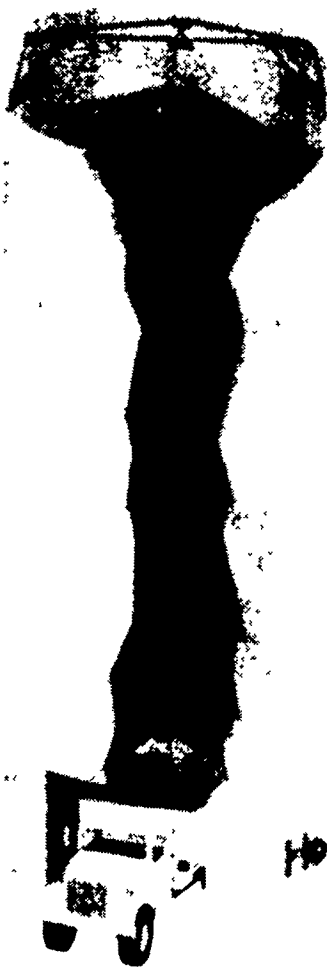
