

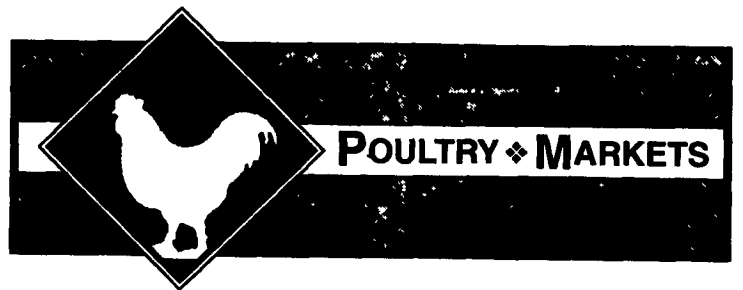

Majority prices on whole eggs were irregular, majority values on other items were unchanged when compared to last week's values. Offerings were usually reported as adequate on yolks and whites but generally available on whole. The undertone was steadier but somewhat unsettled. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending May 06, 2000 were 3 % less than last week, and 5 % less than a year ago. Shell egg suppliers were fully adequate to ample for current needs.
