
FFA Members Are Winners At Regional CDE Contest

The junior prepared winners are from left Margeaux Firestine placing first, Karianne Boyer placing second; and Denise Gardner placing third.



To meet this need, Penn State Cooperative Extension is offering a 17-hour food safety certification course on Tuesdays, June 6, 13, and 20 from 9:30 a m.-4.00 p.m at the Penn Department of Health Regional Office. 665Carey

Avenue in Wilkes-Barre Extension agents, Mary Ehret and Karen Thomas, will be using the National Restaurant Associations' ServSafe course as a basis for the program

At the conclusion of the three-day training, participants take an 80 question exam to qualify for certified food handler status. Participants must attend all three days in order to sit for the exam.
