EASTERN REGION FROZEN EGGS, MAY 19, 2000. FEDERAL-STATE

Majority prices on yolks were unchanged, balance of other items were lower and higher when compared to last week's values. Offerings were usually reported as adequate on yolks and irregular on balance. Interest improved but new trading was still somewhat slow. The undertone was mixed. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending May 13, 2000 were unchanged from last week, and 5% less than a year ago. Shell egg suppliers were fully adequate for current needs.

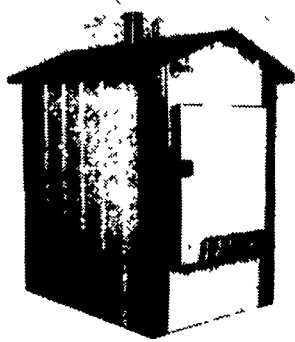

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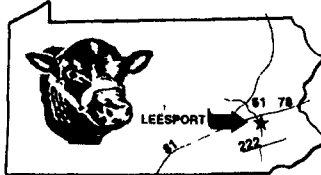
