Demand very light for calves and stockers as wheat harvest just underway and farmers not interested in receiving pasture cattle. Rains in the north a plus for feeders as corn and bean futures dropped sharply Tuesday. Slaughter cows steady to 1.00 higher. Slaughter bulls steady. Packer demand good for light receipts. 
