old BFP contract) did not, however, reflect any change related to weather. Settlement prices for June 2 indicate very little change from the week before. The September and October contract prices are still trading below \$12.50 per cwt.

Finally, USDA reported the May 2000 class and component prices for all federal orders. Product price averages for the month reported in dollars per pound were as follows: butter

\$1.1680, nonfat dry milk \$1.0071, cheese \$1.1022, and dry whey \$0.1760. Component prices in dollars per pound were as follows: butterfat price \$1.2854, nonfat solids price \$0.8530, protein price \$1.5514, and other solids price \$0.0403. Component

prices are important since they show up on farmers' milk checks and affect the calculation of class prices. May class prices in dollars per cwt were as follows: Class II \$12.63, Class III \$9.37, and Class IV \$11.91. The May Class I mover was already announced at \$11.48 per cwt.


