BRUBAKER SALE
The Denver Fire Hall hosted a public sale Saturday on behalf of the late Dr. and Mrs. J.H. Brubaker.

The Brubakers, according to Art Pannebecker Auction Services in Reinholds, were well-known members of the Denver community. The sale of their antiques, toys, and personal property attracted 310 bidders.

Furniture sold included: an eight-piece dining room suite, \$900; a five-piece king-size bedroom suite, \$350; a Victorian sofa, \$775; a bedroom suite, \$270; a Victorian table, \$170; an office cabinet, \$150; a blanket chest, \$240; a slant-top desk, \$350; a spinning wheel, \$270; a small drop-leaf table, \$230; a marble-top stand, \$110; a special chair, \$105; a cedar chest, \$75; a room divider, \$100; and an old grandfather clock, \$350.

scooter, \$90; and a football game, \$75.
