Pennsylvania Milk Marketing **Board Holds Hearing**

HARRISBURG (Dauphin handling costs; reasonable profit Co.) - On July 6, the Milk Marketing Board will conduct a public hearing for Milk Marketing Area 3 for the purpose of receiving evidence concerning minimum prices milk dealers shall pay to producers for various classes of milk; minimum prices milk dealers shall charge for milk, including prices to be charged to wholesale customers such as stores, restaurants, and institutions; discounts; and minimum prices to be charged to consumers for milk sold for consumption off the premises.

Evidence will also be received concerning various types, classifications, and containers of fluid milk and milk products; in-store margins for milk dealers and stores; and adoption of a cost replacement system, including whether in-store handling costs should be a part of that system. The hearing will be held at

8:30 a.m. in Room 202 of the Agriculture Building, 2301 North Cameron Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

Milk Marketing Area 3 consists of the twenty northeastern counties - Potter, Tioga, Bradford, Susquehanna, Wayne, Pike, Monroe, Carbon, Schuylkill, Northumberland, Snyder, Union, Clinton, Lycoming, Sullivan, Wyoming, Lackawanna, Luzerne, Columbia, and Montour.






