

has great potential because it also satisfies consumer concerns with reduced dependence on antibiotics.

The research project on salmonella looked at how surfaces in poultry houses retain salmonella bacteria. Wooden surfaces were found to hide the bacteria deep and the experiment related to painted surfaces and the practical aspects of painting house surfaces.

Fly control was another study. If you can reduce the moisture content of manure, you can reduce fly breeding. If you reduce manure wetness from 80 percent out of the birds to 50 percent, you decrease fly hatch, odor, and manure weight. A combination of tools can be used such as insecticides, fly predators, pit fans, composting in the pit, and belt cage systems.


