**DAIRY CASSEROLE**  
8-ounces noodles, cooked  
1 pound ground beef, fried  
2 cups corn, cooked  
8-ounces cream cheese  
1 can cream of celery soup  
1 cup milk  
Salt and pepper  
Onion salt to taste  
I sometimes add shredded mozzarella on top for taste. Combine all ingredients. Bake 30 minutes at 350 degrees. Use a 2-quart casserole dish.

**YANKEE BREAD**  
2 1/4 cups flour  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 tablespoon yeast  
1 tablespoon honey  
1 cup milk, warmed  
Mix together flour, salt, and yeast. Add warmed milk and honey. Knead a few minutes. Turn on floured board and roll 1/4-inch thick. Cut into one-inch wide strips. A pizza cutter works well for this.

Melt 1/2 cup butter in 9x13-inch pan. Roll each strip dough in butter to coat and lay in pan. Let rise one to four hours for best results (rising isn't necessary but makes better breadsticks). Bake at 375 degrees for 16-18 minutes. Serve warm, plain or with jelly or jam. Makes 10-12 sticks.

**COCONUT DESSERT**  
60 Ritz crackers, crumbled  
1/2 cup butter, melted  
Combine and press into bottom of 9x13-inch cake pan.  
Mix two small packages instant coconut cream pudding and 1 1/2 cups milk. Add half gallon vanilla ice cream. Pour on top of crumbs.

Top with whipped cream topping and sprinkle with flaked coconut or crumbled Ritz crackers. May be frozen or refrigerated, depending on whether you wish to cut it or spoon it from the pan. Because of the ice cream, it must be eaten within a few days.

**FRESH PEACH ICE CREAM**  
4-6 cups soft, ripe peaches, mashed thoroughly (12-15 peaches)  
1/2 pint heavy cream  
1 pint light cream or half and half  
1 1/2 to 2 13-ounce cans evaporated milk  
2 cups sugar, separated  
Mix mashed peaches with 1 cup sugar and blend until dissolved. Combine creams and evaporated milk and another cup of sugar. Stir until thoroughly blended and sugar is dissolved. Carefully combine both mixtures and pour into one-gallon freezer can. Churn until firm. Remove dasher and pack until ready to serve.

This recipe comes from a Florence, S.C. cookbook. The recipe is easy to make and tastes very good. This is one ice cream that is just as delicious one month after it is made as it is the day you make it.

**CHOCOLATE CAKE**  
1 cup butter  
2 cups sugar  
2 eggs  
1 cup buttermilk  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
2 1/2 cups flour  
1/2 cup cocoa  
2 teaspoons baking soda  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 cup boiling coffee  
Cream butter and sugar. Add eggs. Add dry ingredients alternately with milk. Add hot water last. Beat well. Batter will be thin. Bake in 9x13-inch pan at 350 degrees for 30-35 minutes, or until done.

After hip trouble for years, Allen, in his late 40s, underwent

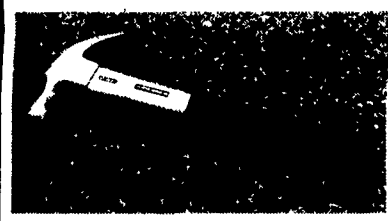
hip replacement operation about a year ago.

He relies on Darryl and the farm hands to get much of the work done. Brad Koval is the herdsman. Other hands are Donald Blair and Mark Snyder.

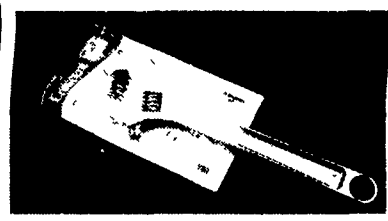
Directions for Day at the Farm: From Somerset follow Route 281 south and watch for signs. From town the distance is 3.5 miles.

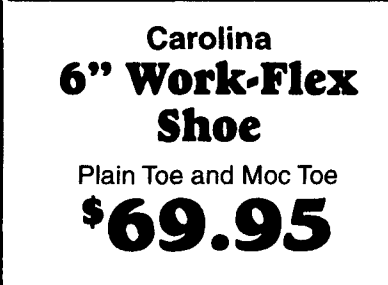
