

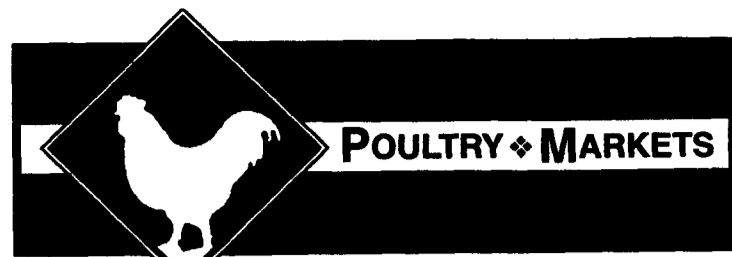

Majority prices on trucklot trading were unchanged to higher on whole, balance unchanged when compared to last week's values. Demand was fair on whites, moderately active on whole, improved and ranged moderate to good on yolks. Supplies were irregular, but inventories were usually adequate for most immediate trade needs. Overall, the undertone improved and was fully steady on yolks and whole, and usually steady on whites. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending June 10, 2000 were 17 % less than last week, and 3 % less than a year ago.

Weights were mostly desirable to heavy. Processing schedules were moderately heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 53 to 65 cents. Trade sentiment was barely steady to weak. In the parts complex, wings were in good balance. Leg items ranged adequate to ample. All other items were at least adequate.

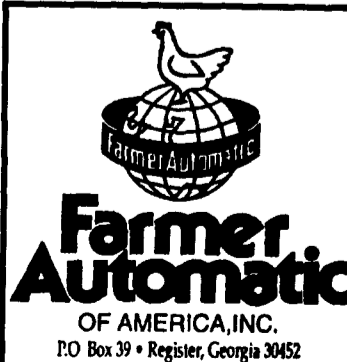
