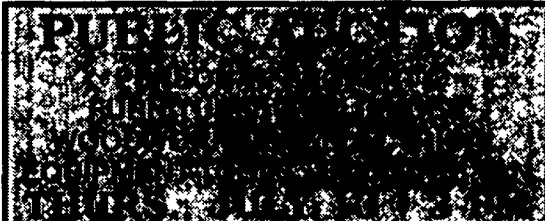
BOBB ESTATE SALE

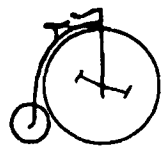
