Majority prices were unchanged on salt yolk, balance of items were generally unchanged to slightly lower when compared to a week earlier. Short term interest was inactive, although some additional inquiry was developing in spot locations. Supplies were irregular, but mostly adequate for immediate trade needs. Undertone was mixed and unsettled. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending June 24, 2000 were 4% less than last week, and 10% less than a year ago. USDA-AMS purchased 1,024,000 lbs. of pasteurized whole eggs to be delivered Aug. 1 to Aug. 15.

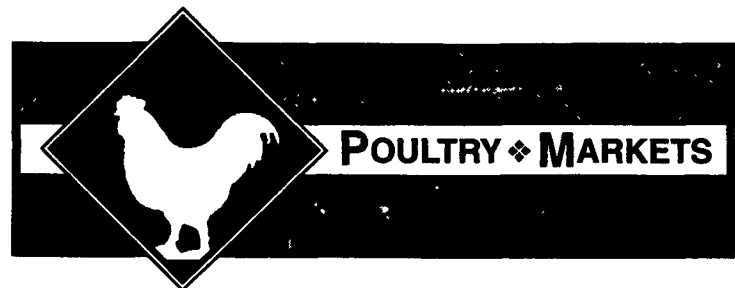
