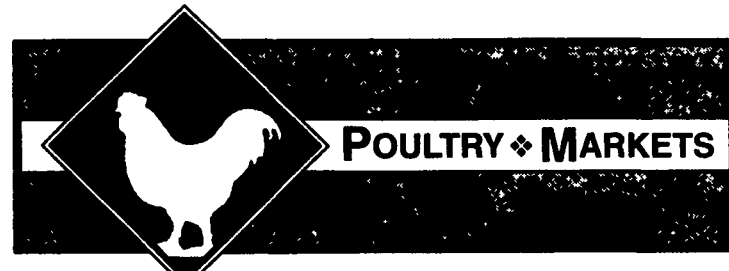

DELMARVA BROILER/FRYER MARKET. FEDERAL-STATE Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was light to fair at best. Seller offerings were fully adequate to ample and were generally more readily available on the larger sizes. Live supplies were at least moderate; weights were mostly desirable to heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 53 to 65 cents. Trade sentiment was generally no better than steady. Inquiry for whole breasts increased and offerings continued to tighten. Wings and tenders continued to clear satisfactorily. Other items were at least adequate for immediate delivery. ACTUAL SLAUGHTER WEEK ENDING 07/15/00 WAS 12,152,243 a 5.11.

Prices were generally unchanged when compared to a week earlier. Demand for immediate movement was mostly slow, although some inquiry was developing for future shipments. Supplies were irregular, but mostly fully adequate for trade needs. Undertone was unsettled but some improvement was noted. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending July 08, 2000 were 6 % less than last week, but 1 % more than a year ago.

IN PHILADELPHIA, PRICES WERE UNCHANGED TO 2 CENTS HIGHER ON ALL SIZES. IN BOSTON, PRICES WERE UNCHANGED TO 2 CENTS HIGHER ON EXTRA LARGE AND MEDIUM AND UNCHANGED TO 1 CENT HIGHER ON LARGE. IN NEW ENGLAND, PRICES WERE 2 CENTS HIGHER FOR EXTRA LARGE THROUGH MEDIUM AND UNCHANGED ON THE BALANCE OF SIZES. THE MARKET TONE CONTINUED FULLY STEADY TO OCCASIONALLY FIRM DEMAND WAS FAIR TO MOSTLY MODERATE, SLIGHTLY BETTER WHERE RETAIL ITEMS WERE FEATURED. SUPPLIES WERE GENERALLY ADEQUATE ON ALL SIZES. BREAKING STOCK OFFERINGS WERE ADEQUATE TO AVAILABLE FOR THE LIGHT TO FAIR DEMAND. LIGHTY TYPE HENS WERE FULLY ADEQUATE FOR CURRENT NEEDS.
