The market tone was fully steady to mostly firm. Demand was mixed in a full range, but was usually moderate to good and was best where widespread feature activity was in progress. Supplies of all sizes were generally adequate to instances barely adequate.

Breaking stock offerings were adequate to available for the light to fair demand. Light type hens were adequate to fully adequate for current needs.

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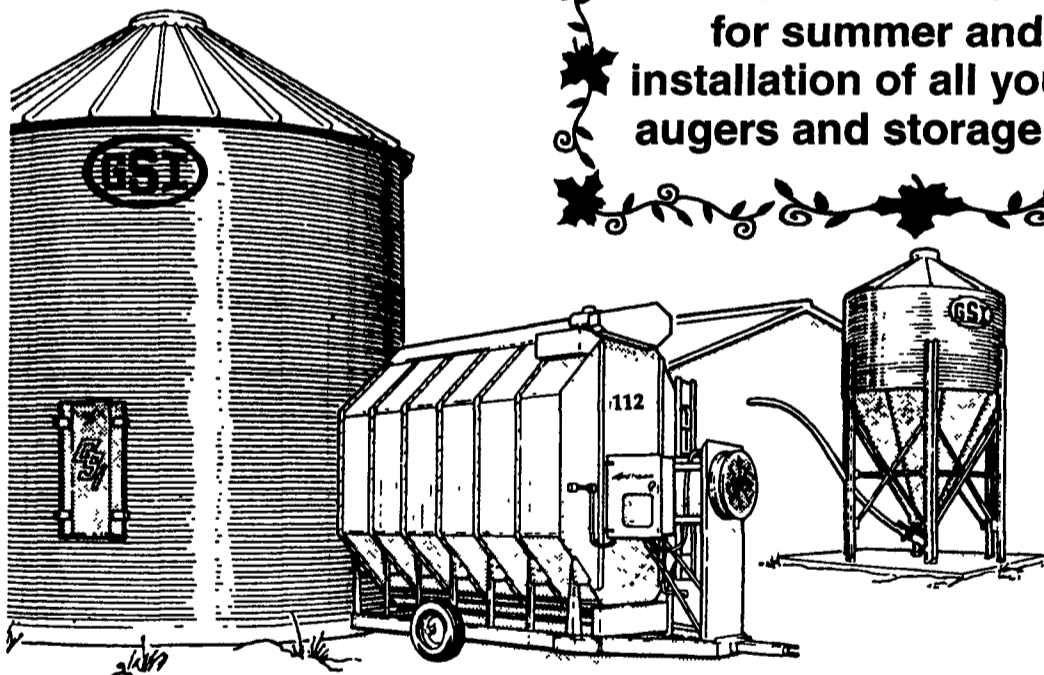
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
