Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was generally limited to previous commitments. Seller offerings were in fairly good balance on the under 3 pound sizes, but were readily available and slow to clear on the heavier weights. Live supplies were at least moderate; weights were desirable to heavier than desired. Processing schedules were moderately heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were mostly 2 cents lower in a range of 47 to 64 cents. Trade sentiment remained weak and unsettled. In the parts complex, inquiry was noted as slow. Offerings were in generally good balance on breast items; adequate to ample on the balance.

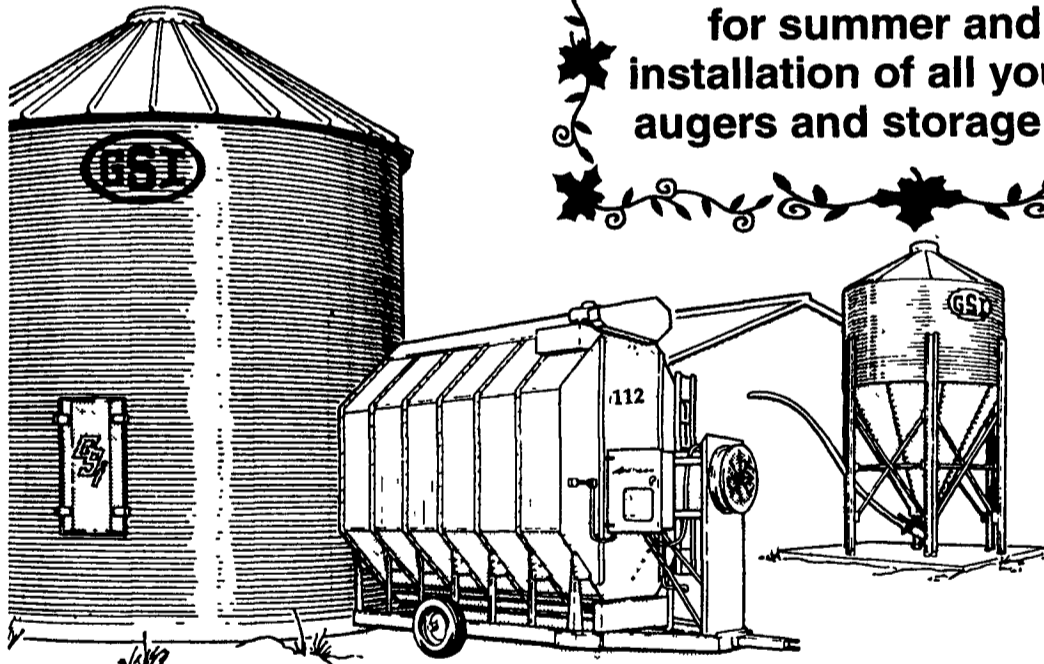

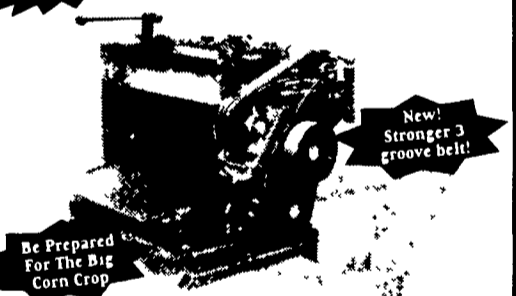
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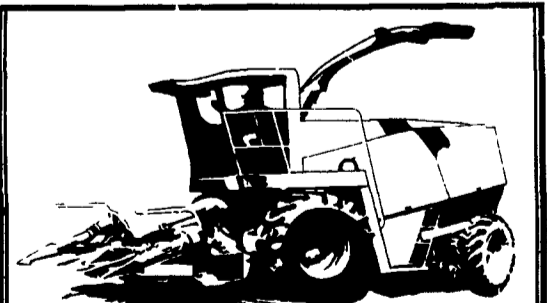
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
