**Alexa Stoner Joins ADA/DC**

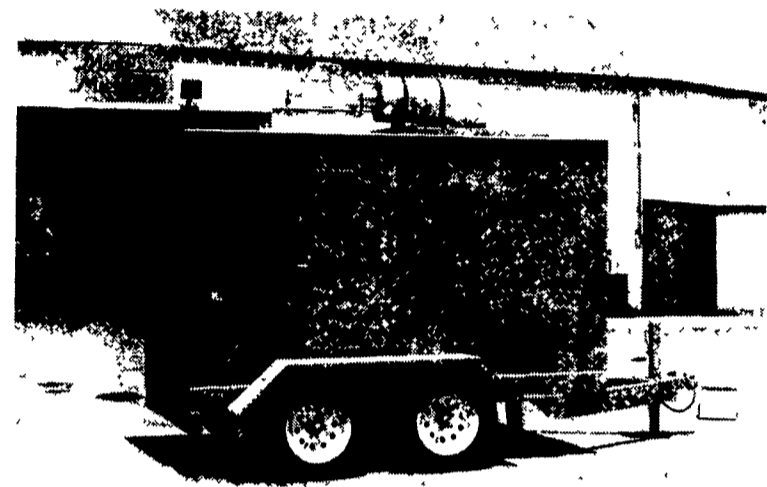

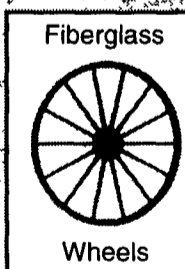

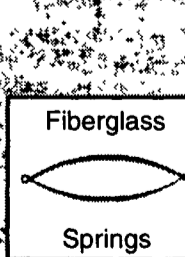
