

# New Ice Cream Flavor To Honor Penn State Dairy Pioneer And Scholar

UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre Co.) — Stuart Patton, Evan Pugh Professor Emeritus in Penn State's College of Agricultural Sciences, was honored for 50 years of research and teaching with symposia, a banquet — and his very own ice cream flavor.

Three symposia and a banquet were held at Penn State's University Park campus. For the banquet, the Penn State Creamery unveiled "Stuzipan," a chocolate ice cream with a distinctive buttery almond flavor.

"The idea of this came from the recognition committee,"

says Craig Baumrucker, professor of animal nutrition and committee chair. "Dr. Patton always researched the chemistry and biology of milk and the mammary gland, so it just seemed like the right thing to do. His wife picked the name as a play on his name and the word marzipan."

Patton joins an exclusive cadre with Penn State ice cream namesakes, including Pennsylvania governor Tom Ridge, Penn State ice cream pioneer Philip Keeney, Penn State dairy

researcher John Almquist and Nittany Lion football coach Joe Paterno. "Stuzipan" was available only during the banquet.

The celebration opened with a symposium on "Dairy-Based Foods and Ingredients" presented by professors from several state universities. The festivities continued with a "Patton Banquet Roast" at the Nittany Lion Inn.

Symposia continued with "Milk Components and Health." Afternoon sessions addressed "Milk and the Mammary Gland Regulation."

Stuart Patton received his bachelor's degree in dairy husbandry from Penn State in 1943 and went on to earn his master's and doctorate from Ohio State

University. He joined Penn State's dairy science faculty in 1949 and became the College of Agricultural Sciences' first Evan Pugh Professor in 1966.

He is known internationally for his research and teaching on milk chemistry and the biological processes that regulate milk synthesis in the mammary gland. He was awarded the 1999 Outstanding Alumni award from Penn State's College of Agricultural Sciences. In recent years, Patton has been adjunct professor in both the department of neurosciences at the University of California-San Diego and in the foods and nutrition program at San Diego State University.
