# **Small-Scale Manure Management Solutions Meeting Sept. 13**

ELLICOTT CITY, Md. - Do you have just a few animals, but are asking yourself, "What do I do with all this manure?'

Attend a meeting Wednesday, Sept. 13, for "Waste Management" Options for Small-Scale Livestock Owners" to hear about some of your options.

This educational meeting is scheduled from 6 p.m.-8 p.m. at the Central Maryland Research and Education Center, Ellicott City.

The meeting will focus on composting animal manure. This technique, when done properly, can make manure easier to handle and can stabilize the nutrients in the manure.

Visitors will learn how to

compost and about different composting methods. On-farm demonstrations will let everyone see how these methods work and what the results are.

Cost for the meeting is \$4 for those who preregister by Sept. 12 and \$6 the day of the meeting. Those who preregister will be eligible to win a free composting starter kit.

The meeting is sponsored by the Maryland Agricultural Experiment Station, Maryland Cooperative Extension, Maryland Horse Council, Howard Soil Conservation District, and Natural Resource Conservation Service. 




