The Lancaster County Farm Service Agency will be accepting acreage reports for all crops through September 1. This extension applies only

to Lancaster County for the year 2000. Farmers can report their crops without paying late fees in order to qualify for certain subsidy payments such as Loan Deficiency payments. Reports will be accepted after September 1 with a filing fee. Refunds will be made to those who already paid the fee.

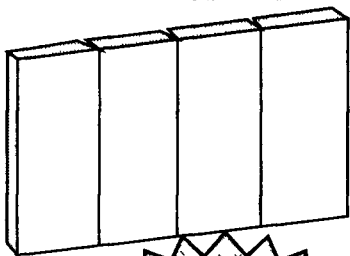

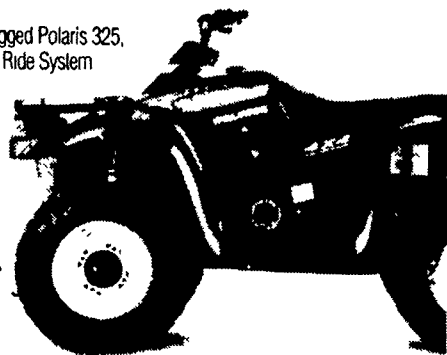

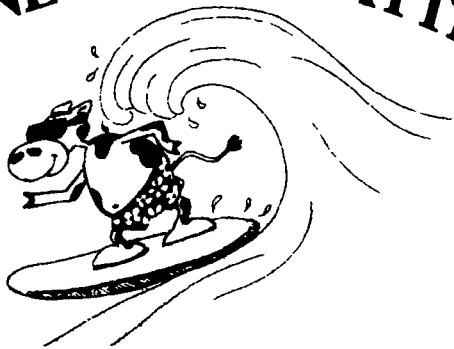
