July Class I Price

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — Recently, the Milk Marketing Board (MMB) announced the prices to be paid to Pennsylvania dairy farmers for July Class I milk as an average of \$16.11 in the western areas of the Commonwealth and an average of \$16.60 in the central and eastern areas of the Commonwealth. Class I milk is beverage type milk.
 These prices do include the current over-order premium of \$1.00 per one hundred pounds

of milk, and the fuel adjustment premium of \$.25 per one hundred pounds of milk is included.
 Since 1988, the MMB has mandated over-order premiums on Class I milk due to adverse conditions affecting the Pennsylvania dairy farmer.
 Chairwoman Beverly R. Minor announced that since the inception of the MMB's over-order premium in 1988, Pennsylvania dairy farmers have received an additional \$209,472,000 in income.

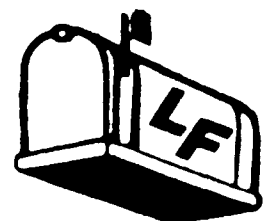
