#### KINETOSCOPE PATENTED

on't know what a kinetoscope is? Thomas Edison received his patent for the incredible device on August 31, 1887 He and his assistant, W K L. Dickson, had hoped the device would do "for the eyes what the phonograph does for the ears" The invention



was immediately popular for its ability to put pictures into motion—depicting a sneeze, for example The kinetoscope was soon replaced by a screen projector, enabling more than one viewer at a time to see the

pictures Edison and Dickson continued their explorations of the moving pictures, however, and opened a studio for their short "flickers" in 1893




