Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds remained only about moderate, but was expected to increase sharply late week as buyers sought receipts for the holiday lengthend weekend. Seller offerings were well balanced to closely cleared on the smaller sizes; ample on the heavier. Live supplies were moderate; weights were mostly desirable. Processing schedules were moderately heavy and some operations were being planned for Saturday. Most plants will shut on Labor Day. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 51 to 68 cents. Trade sentiment was fully steady to firm on 2.5 to 3.5 pound sizes, steady at best on the balance.

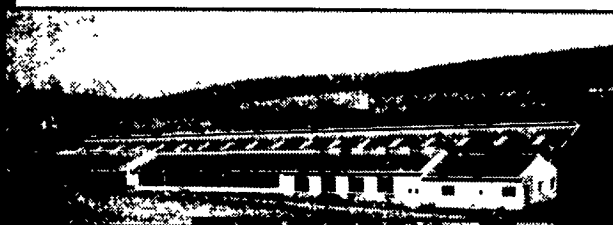
