



pipeline for fresh milk. That's period. why cheese prices normally rally removals of surplus dairy in the fall months.

USDA released a report on the commercial disappearance for milk and select dairy products. This data was reported on a milkfat basis. Over the period January through June of 2000, U.S. milk production was up 3.3

percent. Accounting for increases in beginning stocks (January 1) and imports, the supply of milk was up 4.1 percent. Total commercial disappearance, a proxy for domestic plus export demand for dairy products, was up only 2.9 percent over this same time

Also, government products was also up. As a result, ending stocks as of June 30 increased, up 10.8 percent relative to a year ago.
