Congressman Pitts Makes Annual Farm Tour

LOWER OXFORD (Chester Co.)-Congressman Joe Pitts (R, PA-16) visited farms on Tuesday with stops in Narvon and Iva in Lancaster County, and Lower Oxford and West Grove in Chester County. This was his annual farm tour. Nearly a hundred farmers came out to meet him at the various farms, where he discussed repealing the estate tax, foreign "dumping" of imported produce, and other issues important to agriculture.

"As much or more than any other profession, farmers are getting killed by taxes," said Congressman Pitts. "The 'death tax' takes up to 60 percent of a farm's value when it passes from

one generation to the next. Farmers may own valuable land, but they often have very poor cash flow. How can anyone expect them to pay these taxes? It's no wonder so many farms are going up for sale.

'If we're going to preserve the farms that make Lancaster and Chester counties such special places to live-if we're going to preserve our heritage-we absolutely must make farming a profitable business. We have to stop taxing our farmers to death and we have to help them by opening up new markets and fighting for fair international trade practices."


